



## Beach Road Drainage Project

You have probably noticed that construction along Beach Road and the public Siesta Key Beach. The project will create a storm water treatment program that will clean storm water, drain it into a detention pond and lead water into the Gulf of Mexico.

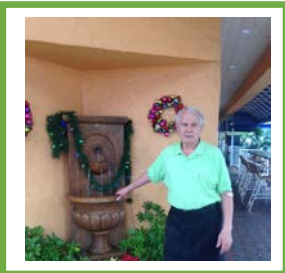


The project includes building a 1 acre detention pond and a treatment system of ultra violet light vaults that will clean the storm water and discharge it into the Gulf of Mexico. Part of the project is the removal of the Australian Pines to make room for the detention pond.
